Boosting Women's Access to Finance by Harnessing the Potential and Capabilities of Women Entrepreneurs



- July 2014: Drafting of concept paper on the proposed special lending program for women entrepreneurs (inspired by WomenBizPH)
- September 2014: Initial meeting between representatives from DBP and WomenBizPH
- November 2014: Signing of a Memorandum of Agreement between DBP and WomenBizPH for the implementation of the ILAW Program



- Empower women by supporting women entrepreneurship
- Help small businesses grow beyond microcredit
- Create jobs and build local economies
- Tap into the network of women organizations and experts



- Simplified lending procedures and requirements
- Dedicated financing window
- Flexible collateral policy
- Customized repayment schedules to match your business cash flow



- Single Proprietorship: Principal should be a woman
- Partnership: Must have at least one (1) woman partner
- Corporation: must have a woman CEO or COO
- Cooperative: Majority of the members
 must be women



- Working capital financing
- Capital expenditures financing
- Confirmed LC/PO financing
- Franchise financing



LOAN AMOUNT

- Minimum of PhP300,000.00
- Up to 90% of total project cost
